



The Kansas Network of Visitation Providers (KNVP) is a not for profit organization that promotes and enhances the provision of child exchange and visitation services in the State of Kansas.

Monitored Exchange: Facilitate the transfer of the child between parents, grandparents, or other family members for unsupervised off-site visitation.

Supervised Parenting Time: Facilitate a safe, neutral environment so children can visit with their nonresidential parent. Staff is present with the child at all times to ensure a safe, supportive environment.



WHO CAN USE THE SERVICES?

Individuals can be referred by the court, attorneys, DV advocates, case managers, law enforcement, mediators, community agencies or self-referrals. Families in need of visitation and exchange services due to mental illness, domestic violence, child abuse, substance use, threat of abduction, criminal activity, or parent-child acquaintance. The intent of services is to help foster positive parent child relationships.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Children are not exposed to conflicts or violence.
- Both parents are able to maintain a relationship with their children.
- Security guards are in place to ensure the safety of parents and children participating in services.
- The neutral atmosphere is child friendly and promotes positive, consistent contact.
- The community benefits by the decrease in public exchanges, such as those at the police station or fast food restaurants.



DID YOU KNOW?

Funding for Centers is provided by federal, state, and local funds; private foundations; and user fees. Centers follow guidelines set by the Office of the Governor and the Attorney General of the State of Kansas.

- Each Center develops its own method of service delivery within the guidelines.
- Each Center is a member in good standing of the National Supervised Visitation Network.
- Most Centers offer additional educational/ support services and referrals to community resources.
